Footnotes

HORNBLOWER allowed to settle through the early stages, slipped into a stalking position down the stretch the first time while racing four wide, advanced on the outside nearing the final turn, collared A LASTING PEACE leaving the final turn and drew clear through the stretch. A LASTING PEACE broke sharply and dueled for the lead entering the first turn racing three wide, opened a clear lead through the lane the first time racing out from the rail, was collared by HORNBLOWER on the final turn, was unable to match strides with that rival in the stretch but battled well to hold the place. TAI SHAN showed no speed while lagging towards the back of the field, raced three wide into the second turn, rallied along the rail on the final turn and closed willingly through the stretch one from the rail. MUCHO VERDE away alertly and chased the early leaders three wide into the first turn, assumed a stalking position through the stretch the first time racing two from the rail, held a striking position into the stretch but faded slightly in the drive. GAVINRYAN away well and saved ground throughout while racing mid pack but lacked the needed closing response. SMARTY FAWCETT stalked the early pace racing three wide into the second turn, rallied two from the rail entering the final turn but hung in the lane. OLAXSA allowed to settle off the early pace racing three wide, but failed to menace. LONG GONE BALDRY unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and was never a factor. TRIBAL SECRET vied for the early lead from along the rail, dropped into a tracking position leaving the first turn, but steadily retreated soon after entering the backstretch.
