Footnotes

THE GOV broke sharply and rushed to the lead entering the first turn racing just out from the rail, turned back a challenge by TIME GOES ON entering the final turn and pulled clear through the stretch. TIME GOES ON away well and tracked the pacesetter while racing three wide through the stretch the first time, loomed a danger three wide entering the final turn, was unable to match strides with THE GOV through the stretch but proved clearly second best. SHINTOISM unhurried early while dropping back to trail, advance along the inside through the stretch the first time to gain a tracking position at the rail, steadied slightly when in tight entering the second turn, tracked the leader into the final turn, and finished evenly in a solid effort. LORD HENRY away alertly and stalked the pacesetter through the first turn while four wide, but lacked the needed closing response over the final stages. SARTORIALIST settled off the early leaders racing one from the rail into the second turn and down the backside, but lacked the needed closing response. WITH COUNCIL was carried four wide entering the first turn, dropped back to trail, posted a mild rally three wide entering the final turn but hung in the late stages.
