O'GEORGE broke sharply, chased three wide into the first turn, continued along on the outside down the backstretch, rallied four wide into the stretch and was up in the final strides. STORY'S END stalked the pace while racing along the inside, was forced to check mid way through the final turn when in tight, re-rallied between rivals in the stretch to just miss. I'MARAINBOWRIDER trailed the field while racing out from the rail, began to close four wide on the final turn, and was closing fastest of all in the stretch from the far outside. GIUSEPPE'S RUNNER chased the pacesetter three wide down the backstretch, rallied two wide on the final turn, but was outfinished in the stretch. SIMILKAMEEN STORM away alertly, led while racing just out from the rail, held a clear advantage into the stretch, but tired late. TIMEFORACOLDONE unhurried early, saved ground but lacked any rally. J J'S TRAVELER away well, chased the pace from along the rail, and faded in the stretch.
