LINDEN'S LADY broke sharply, assumed command and drew clear, led throughout and prevail being ridden out. EPICUREAN hustled along and gaining, three wide on the backstretch, rallied and was second best. BELLA AVIVA broke sharply, well paced, chased the leaders from the inside, went evenly. DIVA BALLERINA never far back, tracked the leaders from off the rail, put in a mild bid from three wide and finished well. POSTESS hustled along and three wide, chased the leaders, was through after the half. MAYBINEE slow early, showed little and was never a threat. GINGER BLOSSOM unhurried early, showed little and failed to menace. TAMAHI away alertly, dropped back, trailed far back.
