QUILLO'S INTENTION chased the pacesetters while saving ground at the rail, rallied along the inside entering the final turn, tipped three wide into the stretch and quickly made the lead and began to draw clear. COATLUCUE broke inwards and bumped with DESPERATE and TAMARINDA, dueled two wide throughout, and battled gamely in a solid effort. DESPERATE broke out and bumped with COATLUCUE, chased the pacesetters two wide into the first turn, swung four wide into the stretch, and was closing well late. UPPER CRUST showed no speed early, trailed the field down the backstretch, rallied three wide on the final turn and improved her position in the stretch. TAMARINDA away alertly, was bumped soon after the start by COATLUCUE, rushed up to vie for the lead from along the rail, held a narrow advantage leaving the final turn, but weakened late. DELTA BOUQUET unhurried early, raced one from the rail, but lacked any kind of rally. Following the race the stewards conducted an enquiry into the start of the race. After review there was no change in the running order.
