ROMANCIN TRAVELLER rushed up to clear the field and get the rail entering the first turn, opened a clear advantage entering the final turn, and was never challenged late. PROFIT'S STAR was carried three wide into the first turn, chased the pacesetter two wide down the backstretch, was unable to threaten the winner in the stretch, but finished well to hold the place. THE BARTON BOY carried four wide into the first turn, continued to chase the pacesetter from the four path down the backstretch, and battle gamely to the wire. FRANSOR'S FINEST drifted wide into the first turn, carrying rivals with him to his outside, chased between rivals down the backside, but faded in the final furlong. TAME THE TIGER carried three wide into the first turn, angled in to save ground down the backstretch, but was only able to muster a mild bid. MADOC hesitated at the break to get away very slowly, began to advance between rivals down the backside, rallied three wide on the final turn to improved his position. CLEVER MOMENT raced four wide throughout, and failed to threaten. SAGEHILL'S STORM steadied while drifting out approaching the first turn, swung three wide into the turn when forced to check again from between rivals when FRANSOR'S FINEST drifted entering the turn, raced mid pack down the backstretch, and only offered a mild bid nearing the final turn. MINSTREL'S TIME away alertly, was quickly taken back towards the rear of the field, and offered little thereafter.
