Footnotes

MACHO QUITO away well, but was taken back off the early leaders racing two from the rail, advanced four wide soon after entering the backstretch to gain a striking position, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, and prevailed after a stretch long battle with CAPTIAN HINK. CAPTAIN HINK vied for the lead entering the first turn racing just out from the rail, battled for the lead throughout while the rider fought to keep him in the two path, held the lead into the final turn, was collared by MACHO QUITO mid way through the turn, battled with that rival through the stretch and just failed to last. FRIAR TUCK unhurried early while dropping back to trail, advanced four wide down the backstretch, rallied three wide on the final turn and was gaining in the stretch drive. SHINGEN BOLT stalked the early leaders while racing three wide through the second turn, loomed a danger four wide mid way down the backstretch but hung over the final furlong. TAME THE TIGER broke sharply and tracked the early leaders racing one from the rail, advanced from along the rail mid way down the backstretch to loom a threat, but weakened over the final furlong. STONERIDGE ROCKET away alertly and dueled for the early lead three wide into the second turn, had the saddle slip entering the backstretch, causing the rider to lose his irons, and ended all chances as he was eased in the stretch.
