BLUEGRASS PRIDE away well and stalked the early leaders while racing one from the rail through the stretch the first time, tracked the pacesetters to the final turn from along the rail, tipped three wide leaving the turn and quickly drew clear. MONAHEE broke sharply and tracked the leader through the stretch the first time, and down the backside while racing one from the rail, rallied two wide into the stretch, was no match for the winner, but battled on gamely to hold the place. MY DUBAI steadied while running into the bit entering the first turn, tipped three wide entering the stretch the first time while holding a stalking position, rallied three wide on the final turn, and closed four wide in the drive. PAYTON'S BEST away alertly and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, battled into the final turn from the inside of MONAHEE, but faded in the stretch drive. WHO'S DADDY IS DAT settled off the early pace racing three wide into the stretch the first time, continued from a three wide trip down the backstretch and lacked the needed response when called upon approaching the final turn. AFLEET CHANCE was slow into stride while trailing the field into the first turn, advanced from along the rail entering the second turn to get into contention, but began to drop back soon after entering the backstretch.
