Footnotes

BANK pressed the early pace while racing one from the rail, took command entering the final turn, and was able to hold off a closing PRINCESS RULE in the late stages. PRINCESSES RULE unhurried early, raced one from the rail into the first turn and down the backstretch, rallied between rivals approaching the final turn, tipped three wide into the stretch, and was closing ground late. QUEEN'S VICAR broke sharply, raced two wide into the first turn, pressed three wide down the backstretch, and finished evenly. LA BRONCA no speed early, split rivals entering the final turn to rally one from the rail, and closed ground in the stretch racing just off the rail. LUISINA away alertly, vied for the early lead from along the rail, but began to weaken on the final turn. LA BELLE ROSE rallied three wide upon entering the backstretch to reach contention, but hung the final furlong. CASHINO ROYALE away well, chased the pace from along the rail into the first turn, began to fall back in the run down the backside, and tired. CANADIAN SPRINGS showed little, and was never a factor.
