DEVIL IN DISGUISE tracked the pace from along the rail through the second turn and down the backside, was forced to steady while awaiting room nearing the final turn, tipped three wide to commence his bid on the turn, took command entering the stretch and quickly drew clear. THE GOV away well and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, held the lead into the final turn, was collared mid way through the turn by CLEAR the runway, had no response when DEVIL IN DISGUISE rallied three wide and took command entering the stretch, but re-rallied to claim the place. CLEAR THE RUNWAY broke sharply and chased the early pacesetter one from the rail through the stretch the first time and down the backstretch, rallied two wide on the final turn, and took a brief lead mid way through the turn, was quickly engaged by DEVIL IN DISGUISE and had no response to that challenge and just failed to hold on for the place. MYSTERIOUS SOUL unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied three wide on the final turn and finished well through the lane. DEPUTY'S COMMAND allowed to settle through the early going racing one from the rail, rallied two wide on the final turn, but lacked the needed closing kick. LORD HENRY away alertly and tracked the leader three wide into the stretch the first time, but was through mid way down the backstretch.
