WHYISTHERUMGONE away well, and vied for the lead into the turn from the inside of DR SPORT, took command entering the stretch and was able to hold off the late finishers. NIGHT ARREST chased the battling leaders into the turn racing one from the rail, and closed gamely through the stretch four wide to get up for the place. OLE'S MISS broke sharply and rushed up between rivals in the run away from the gate, steadied when in tight quarters approaching the turn, chased along the inside through the turn and closed willingly one from the rail in the lane. DR SPORT away alertly and dueled for the lead one from the rail through the turn, was unable to match strides with the winner in the stretch drive, and was outfinished late for the minor awards. SKYTASTIC chased the leaders four wide into the turn, and closed with interest while gaining ground five wide in the lane. HOLIDAY BABE was off a step slow, chased three wide through the turn, showed some late interest, but was never a threat. WEE HARRY was devoid of the early speed needed to contend early, chased one from the rail through the turn, but was never a factor. FINALLY FIRST saved ground while racing along the inside through the turn, but was never a factor.
