WHATASENSEOFHUMOR away well, and pressed the pace three wide entering the first turn, assumed command entering the final turn and quickly opened a clear lead through the turn and widened his margin through the stretch. I'M BIG TROUBLE lagged well back in the early going racing one from the rail into the backstretch, rallied four wide entering the final turn and closed strongly five wide in the lane to get up for the place. CONTACT MAN away alertly and tracked the leaders into the backstretch from along the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn, was no match for the winner, but just failed to hold on for the place. GOLDEN FLASH settled off the early leaders in the run to the backstretch, rallied two wide on the final turn and improved his position over the final furlong without seriously threatening. KENO MAGIC unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied along the inside on the final turn, and closed three wide in the stretch with late interest. EXTRAMOON chased the leaders five wide in to the first turn, raced wide down the backside and through the final turn, and lacked any closing response while remaining wide in the stretch drive. FINAL MIRACLE broke sharply and raced to a narrow lead entering the first turn while racing one from the rail, battled to the final turn, before weakening. NULLARBOR chased the pacesetter four wide into the first turn, rallied along

the inside entering the final turn, but weakened in the lane. STORMIN CANDY was bumped soon after the start, and then ducked in slightly leaving the chute, rushed up to track the leaders into the first turn, engaged the pacesetters three wide mid way down the backside, but stopped entering the final turn. BOOTS GRAY reared at the start, and never left the gate, and was walked off the track. Following the running of this race the stewards conducted an inquiry into the start of the race. After review they deemed that BOOTS GRAY did not receive a fair start and declared him a non starter, and ordered a full refund on all wagers involving this horse.
