TAYLOR SAID away alertly and rushed to the lead entering the first turn while racing two from the rail, vied for the lead from the inside of NORTHERN CAUSEWAY down the backside, took a narrow advantage into the final turn and drew clear through the stretch drive. ST LIAMS HALO broke sharply and chased the early pace while three wide into the stretch the first time, tracked the leaders down the backside racing two from the rail, loomed a threat mid way through the final turn, but was unable to match strides with TAYLOR SAID through the lane but proved clearly second best. SENOR ROJO stalked the early pace racing just out from the rail, rallied two wide on the final turn and was up for a share in the stretch in a game effort. THREE WOOD allowed to settle through the early going racing two from the rail, rallied two wide entering the final turn, awaited room briefly mid way through the turn and finished well. CREW LEADER stalked the pacesetters while racing three wide into the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn and improved his position without ever threatening. MAJESTICALITY unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied four wide on the final turn but needed more. SILLY FELLA away well and chased the early leaders into the backstretch from along the rail, tracked the dueling pacesetters into the final turn before weakening. NORTHERN CAUSEWAY was forced to steady when in tight at the rail on the first turn, pulled his way between rivals entering the stretch the first time and challenged for the lead, dueled to the outside of TAYLOR SAID down the backside and into the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive.
