WOODSHED broke sharply, pressed the pace from three wide, gained the lead on the second turn, prevailed driving. VYING FOR GLORY broke sharply, assumed command and the rail, set the pace, steadied on the backstretch, came again from three wide, closed and just missed. SIMPLY SAM broke sharply, pressed the pace from between horses, gained a short lead on the backstretch, gave way. DUBA never far back, stalked the pace, three wide on the second turn, weakened. I'M FAMOUS never far back, saved ground, tracked the leaders, was through after the half. VIA COL VENTO slow early, trailed throughout and showed little.
