Footnotes

CASTINETTE DANCER away well, stalked the early pacesetters while racing one from the rail, rallied three wide on the final turn, and four wide into the stretch, and ran by BURNIN' BRITCHES in late stretch. BURNIN' BRITCHES broke sharply, chased two wide into the first turn, engaged OVERVALUED down the backstretch and battled for the lead, opened a clear lead mid way through the final turn, but had no response when collared by CASTINETTE DANCER in deep stretch. OVERVALUED away alertly, led while racing at the rail entering the first turn,dueled down the backside from along the rail, lost the lead entering the final turn, but ran on in the lane. CAMINO ducked in soon after the start, trailed the field through the final turn, and was only able to pass a tiring foe in the stretch. PIGTAILS unhurried early racing one from the rail, and never menaced.
