BRYMIC'S GEM broke sharply, assumed command, led throughout, drew off driving. RAINBOWSNLADYBUGS broke sharply, pressed the pace from off the rail, finished well as second best. THERUSSIANROCKET away alertly and well placed, stalked the pace from off the rail, weakened in the stretch. IS KATIE EATING never far back, gaining from off the rail, was outrun in the stretch. MAGIC THUNDER slow early, showed little and failed to respond. MARSEILLE PEARL hustled along to be well placed, weakened early. STORYTIME in the middle of the pack, saved ground, weakened. KID SLICK slow early, showed little and was not a threat. PUNCH BACK slow early, trailed throughout.
