Footnotes

JOY OF THE LORD away well, stalked the pacesetters racing one from the rail,rallied four wide entering the final turn, and was up in the late stages under steady urging. ORCHID'S SILVER chased two wide into the first turn while challenging for the early lead, led down the backstretch while racing just off the rail, battled gamely in the stretch but was unable to hold off JOY OF THE LORD in the late stages. EL CUGAT showed no speed early while dropping back to trail, raced three wide down the backside, rallied four wide on the final turn and closed willingly to get up for a share. BOBBY HANDY away alertly, chased three wide into the first turn, pressed two wide down the backstretch while challenging for the lead, held a narrow advantage entering the stretch, but was outfinished in the drive. GOOD BAD N UGLY broke sharply, took back just off the early pacesetters while saving ground at the rail, but was unable to make up ground when called upon. AZTEC RULER raced wide throughout, posted a mild bid nearing the final turn, but hung in the stretch drive. B R REMARK was squeezed soon after the start, and never menaced. KALOOKAN BOSS raced two from the rail into the first turn, chased four wide down the backstretch, but faded on the final turn.
