Footnotes

POSTESS away alertly, vied for the lead from along the rail,was pressed through the final turn before inching away in the stretch drive. SNOWBIRD PASS broke sharply, dueled for the lead with POSTESS from the onset while racing one from the rail, couldn't stay with that foe in the stretch, but held well for the place. LADY SAFFRON chased the pacesetters while racing three wide throughout, was unable to make up ground in an even effort. SONIA'S MANE GIRL chased two wide into the first turn, advanced three wide mid way down the backstretch but lacked the needed closing response. DANNY'S CHANT away well, raced along the rail throughout, but was unable to mount a challenge. VICTOR'S QUEEN unhurried early, raced along the rail until approaching the final turn, tipped three wide the post a mild bid but never threatened. SUKITORI squeezed at the start, raced wide throughout and showed little. VICKY C. had a wide trip and never menaced. REGALLY FREE showed no speed and dropped back to trail and was never a factor.
