Footnotes

SLEW'S PRODIGY never far back, tracked the leaders from three wide, rallied on the two path, gained the lead at mid stretch, prevailed driving. SMART CALL unhurried early, put in a late rally on the inside, finished well as second best. MOSEL RIVER broke sharply, assumed command and drew clear, set the pace, gave way. MOBIL SUPREME away alertly, stalked the pace from three and four wide, weakened in the stretch. AQUISTADORE in the middle of the pack, tracked the leaders from three and four wide, five wide in the stretch, was outfinished. PERFECT CONTENDER trailed for the first half mile, found his best stride late wide a six wide rally in the stretch. MOONCORE broke sharply and close up, chased the pace setter from off the rail, gained the lead on the final turn, gave way. LONG GONE BALDRY slow early, gaining from three wide, failed to menace. KARAZTECA unhurried early, stalked the pace from off the rail, was not a threst. STREET PATROL slow early, gaining from three wide, had no late move. BOSS broke sharply, tracked the leaders from off the rail, was through early and dropped back. CROW CREEK in the middle of the pack, gaining from four wide, was through after three quarters.
