### Footnotes

EL SINALOENSE broke sharply and gained command, led throughout, drew clear on the turn and was ridden out. WHAT R THE ODDS broke sharply, chased the winner from off the rail, finished well as second best. CRITICAL CHOICE broke sharply and was well placed, stalked the leaders and finished well. PEPPERMINT KISSES hustled along to be well placed on the inside, stalked the pace and was next best. ALL THE VICES unhurried early, stalked the pace, failed to menace. ANY SUNDAY away alertly, bumped early, was always outrun. GO SWEETLY unhurried early, showed little and was never a threat. REGAL SHANEL slow early, trailed throughout.
