Footnotes

CAMINO away well and rushed to the lead approaching the first turn while getting to the rail, raced on an uncontested lead down the backstretch, increased her margin entering the final turn and drew clear through the stretch under steady urging. RANDOM HIGHS unhurried early while dropping back to trail through the early stages, rallied three wide on the final turn, and closed well four wide through the stretch to prove clearly second best. VYING TY GRR allowed to settle off the early leaders while angling in to save ground entering the first turn, trailed the field into the final turn, rallied one from the rail on the turn, tipped four wide entering the stretch and closed with interest. VICTORY WITH CLASS away alertly and dropped into a stalking position one from the rail entering the backside, rallied three wide on the final turn, but hung in the stretch drive. INCLUDE THE GRAND tracked the early leader from along the rail into the first turn and down the backside, but began to weaken mid way through the final turn. NICOTIANA broke sharply and tracked the leader into the first turn, tipping off the rail to race in the two path, continued to chase the lone front runner through the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive.
