Footnotes

SWONGS tracked the dueling leaders while saving ground at the rail, advanced one from the rail from between rivals entering the final turn to challenge for the lead, took command through the final turn and inched clear. MEAUX POWER allowed to settle well off the early leaders while saving ground along the inside, tipped off the rail approaching the final turn to commence a four wide rally, and closed willingly through the stretch to prove clearly second best. AMBEKAY unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied three wide into the final turn and closed four wide through the stretch to get up for a share. PASSION RED away alertly and dueled for the early lead one from the rail entering the first turn, dropped into a tracking position in the run down the backside racing one from the rail, but faded in the late stages. TURNAGAIN TAYLOR was off slowly and chased three wide into the first turn, and lacked the needed closing response while still able to improve his position over the final furlong. HUFFMAN away well and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, assumed command in the run down the backstretch, was collared entering the final turn and faded over the final furlong. DE CAR GUY raced mid pack into the backside racing one from the rail, advanced along the inside entering the final turn to gain a striking position, but weakened in the stretch drive. SLICKSTER broke sharply and tracked the leaders into the backstretch racing two from the rail, chased the pace into the final turn before tiring.
