SUPER STEVE broke sharply and raced to the lead entering the first turn from along the race, set a pressured pace down the backstretch, turned back ONE'S OWN ACCORD entering the stretch and drew clear. KALOOKAN BOSS allowed to settle well off the early pacesetters, rallied one from the rail entering the final turn, tipped four wide into the stretch and closed willingly to prove second best. ONE'S OWN ACCORD away alertly and pressed the pace one from the rail entering the first turn, battled through the final turn from the outside of SUPER STEV but faded slightly in the stretch drive in a game effort. KWIK unhurried early while dropping back to trail, raced three wide through the second turn and down the backside, rallied four wide on the final turn and closed willingly through the stretch. OUTOFTHECLOUDS tracked the dueling leaders down the backstretch racing one from the rail, rallied three wide on the final turn, but needed more when called upon. DIABLO PASS showed no early speed while lagging well back of the early leaders, saved ground into the backstretch but failed to menace. HORNBLOWER away well and pressed the pace three wide from the onset, but weakened in the late going.
