GANBEI stalked the early pace while saving ground at the rail, slipped through along the inside to take command approaching the final turn, and held a closing INHISGLORY safe in the late stages. INHISGLORY away well and vied for the early lead from along the inside, eased back into a tracking position behind dueling leaders approaching the second turn, rallied three wide on the final turn, loomed a threat entering the stretch, but was unable to sustain his bid while proving clearly second best. ROSES FOR BEN allowed to settle well off the early pace while saving ground at the rail, advanced along the inside approaching the final turn, was forced to steady when in tight quarters approaching the final turn, closed well through the lane to get up for a share. TRICK OF THE NORTH allowed to settle off the early leaders while racing just off the rail, rallied at the rail on the final turn tipped four wide entering the stretch and closed willingly. BRASS PLATE unhurried early while dropping back to trail, raced three wide down the backside, rallied five wide into the final turn, was forced to check sharply when carried out entering the turn and finished well from the middle of the track. FRANSOR'S FINEST away alertly and tracked the early pacesetter one from the rail through the stretch the first time, but began to weaken mid way down the backstretch. JUMP UP AND KISSME stalked the early pace while racing three wide into the second turn, remained within striking position entering the final turn but was carried wide entering the turn and faded in the stretch drive. STORMY CANUCK broke sharply and pressed the early pace three wide into the first turn, vied for the lead from along the inside entering the second turn and down the backside, but weakened over the final furlong. STOLENOTIS rushed up four wide mid way through the first turn, and

pressed the pacesetter one from the rail entering the second turn, battled from the outside of STORMY CANUCK into the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive. DYNA STROLL allowed to settle through the early going racing two from the rail, rallied five wide into the final turn, carrying rivals out entering the turn and hung over the final furlong.
