Footnotes

P S FORGET ME NOT unhurried early, raced four wide down the backstretch, was five wide while closing ground on the final turn, and closed with a rush from the middle of the track to run down BLAME THE BUBBLY. BLAME THE BUBBLY allowed to settle off the early pace, advanced three wide mid way down the backstretch,engaged THE BARTON BOY for the lead approaching the final turn, held a clear lead into the stretch, but was unable to hold off the late charge of P S FORGET ME NOT. SILVER CITY SAM away well, saved ground while racing at the rail throughout, and was closing well late. THE BARTON BOY broke sharply, vied for the early lead one from the rail, opened a clear lead entering the stretch the first time, was re-engaged by FULL TIME DUKE entering the second turn, was collared approaching the final turn, and faded in the stretch. CHAPEL BOY raced two wide throughout, and lacked the needed response. FULL TIME DUKE away alertly, vied early from along the rail, re-engaged the leader two wide going into the second turn, couldn't keep up down the backside, and tired in the final furlong. FOREVERINTIME unhurried early, raced two wide throughout, and never threatened.
