MR. MAJESTIC away well, but ducked in when shying away from a rival in the run from the gate, allowed to settle off the early leaders racing two from the rail into the first turn, advanced along the inside down the backside, rallied three wide into the final turn, angled in and closed from the rail entering the stretch to get up in time. MAJOR LEVEL ducked in at the start, shying away from a rival and bumping the rail in the early going, assumed a stalking position from along the rail down the backside, rallied five wide entering the final turn and was up for the place in the closing strides. STRONG REALITY away alertly and angled in leaving the gate causing a chain reaction of horses ducking in, tracked the leaders through the first turn, advanced three wide approaching the final turn, assumed command entering the turn, but faded in the stretch drive. FEI YING unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied four wide into the final turn and closed six wide through the stretch, while gaining ground on the leaders. RAY'S RENO was forced to steady early when in tight at the rail, and clipped heels when MAJOR LEVEL dropped over in front of him, saved ground throughout while racing along the rail, while unable to threaten. BERTORNEY broke sharply and raced to the lead into the first turn racing one from the rail, dueled down the backside from the inside of SRI LANKER, but faded over the final furlong. SRI LANKER chased the early leader into the first turn racing three wide, pressed the pace from the outside of BERTORNEY down the backside but weakened over the final furlong.
