HERBIE D away alertly, dueled one from the rail for the early lead, took command approaching the final turn and was able to hold the closers at bay. GYPSY MAGIC away well, tracked the leaders while racing just off the rail, rallied two wide on the final turn, and closed three wide in the stretch but proved to be second best. PROFIT'S STAR brushed the side of the gate at the break, raced mid pack three from the rail, commenced a four wide rally on the final turn and closed five wide in the lane to get up for a share. VIMANA broke sharply, stalked the pacesetters while racing in the three path, chased four wide into the final turn but lacked the needed closing response. CLEVER MOMENT raced four wide throughout in an even effort. CAT'S AXE rushed up to vie for the early lead from along the rail entering the first turn, dueled down the backstretch along the inside of HERBIE D, but weakened in the final furlong. MADOC dwelt at the start, raced two wide throughout, and never menaced. LUNAR SPRING raced erratic through the stretch the first time, drifted six wide into the first turn, continued on from the outside, and was through early. OTTOMAN hit the side of the gate at the break, raced two wide into the first turn, but was never a factor.
