SENIOR ROJO broke sharply, allowed to settle off the early leaders while saving ground at the rail, advanced along the inside mid way down the backstretch, briefly awaited room mid way through the final turn, left the rail to split rivals and quickly engaged SPAGHETTI MOUSE for the lead entering the lane, and proved best. SPAGHETTI MOUSE away well, chased TOMMY DANZIGGER from two off the rail into the stretch the first time, pressed the pace two wide down the backstretch, held a narrow advantage entering the stretch but could not hold off the closing bid from SENOR ROJO. THREE WOOD chased three wide into the first turn, hustled four wide down the backstretch, rallied three wide on the final turn, and battled gamely to the wire. TRICK OF THE NORTH raced two wide into the first turn, dropped back to trail mid way down the backside, re-rallied in the stretch three wide to finish with interest. GANBEI raced two from the rail into the first turn, advanced three wide upon entering the backside to close the gap, raced four wide on the final turn, but hung in deep stretch. TOMMY DANZIGGER away alertly, led from along the rail, was engaged by SPAGHETTI MOUSE down the backstretch, lost the lead entering the lane and faded.
