Footnotes

LADY SASHA away alertly, held a narrow advantage racing one from the rail, turned back the challenge from OLAXSA entering the stretch and quickly drew clear. OLAXSA broke sharply, pressed the pace racing three wide into the second turn, dueled two wide down the backstretch and on the final turn, couldn't match strides with LADY SASHA in the stretch, but proved second best. MARKET FLAIR unhurried early, raced two wide throughout and rallied between rivals entering the stretch to close for a share. RIGHT HONORABLE raced two wide around the first turn, saved ground down the backside and into the final turn but lacked the needed response in the stretch. MR. ICHIBAN chased four wide throughout, but was only able to post a mild bid down the backstretch. SMART CALL away well, dropped back to trail, and never menaced.
