Footnotes

LATE AFFAIR away well, chased the early pacesetter three wide into the first turn and down the backstretch, engaged VYING TY GRR approaching the final turn and quickly opened a clear lead, and drew off in the stretch. NOTIS HER broke sharply, chased the pace one from the rail, rallied three wide on the final turn and got up for the place. MIZZ SHAKIN raced three wide into the first turn, rallied four wide on the final turn and into the stretch and was gaining in the drive. SWEET N SOUR raced mid pack, advanced along the rail down the backstretch to get into striking position, but hung in the late stages. RANDOM HIGHS unhurried early while saving ground at the rail, closed five wide in the lane. VYING TY GRR away alertly, led entering the first turn from along the rail, raced just off the rail down the backside, but weakened in the final furlong.
