TOO MUCH DIRT unhurried early while racing one from the rail, tipped four wide to commence his rally entering the final turn, and closed strongly to take command in deep stretch. ARRAIGNMENT broke sharply, vied for the lead from along the rail, held a clear advantage into the stretch, was unable to hold off TOO MUCH DIRT late, but battled gamely to the wire. STORMY CANUCK away alertly, dueled for the early lead one from the rail, chased three wide around the final turn, and closed willingly along the inside in the stretch drive. TARUE GRIT away well, raced three wide into the first turn and entering the backstretch, mounted a two wide bid mid way down the backside, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, but hung late. OUTFOTHECLOUDS showed no early speed while trailing the field into the stretch drive, swung five wide and closed with interest. PATZCUARO chased the early pacesetters from along the rail, but began to fade nearing the final turn.
