GOTTA FIND BUBBA trailed early, gaining from off the rail, rallied from four wide, gained the lead in the late stretch and won driving. TOMMY DANZIGGER hustled along and four wide on the first turn to get position, chased the leaders, rallied from four wide, gained a short lead at mid stretch, gave way. TEST PILOT away alertly and close up, chased the leaders from the inside, gained the lead on the final turn, gave way. AFLEET DEAL broke sharply, pressed the pace from three wide, weakened after three quarters. TRIBAL TEEN broke sharply, gained command, set a pressured pace from off the rail, gave way. ROYAL RAGS slow early, showed little and was not a threat. GILDED OPPORTUNITY broke sharply, dropped back and showed little.
