ROMANCIN TRAVELLER tracked the battling leaders through the turn racing along the inside, waited room leaving the turn, slipped through entering the stretch and closed willingly from along the rail in deep stretch to get up in time. PRINCIPE'S HERBIE broke sharply and dueled for the lead from the outside of SNOWBIRD PASS through the turn and into the stretch, but was nipped in the final strides in a solid effort. SNOWBIRD PASS away well and vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, and battled from between rivals in the stretch drive to just miss. CHEROKEE TEAR was squeezed at the start to get away slowly, chased the leaders four wide through the turn and closed with late interest five wide in the drive. VERNON CAT steadied when in tight at the rail mid way to the turn, chased three wide through the turn, and closed four wide in the lane but was unable to overcome the early issue. BOOGIE BUTT away alertly and chased the pacesetters three wide into the turn, but was through before reaching the lane.
