MARKETWAY away well and stalked the dueling leaders into the backstretch racing one from the rail, engaged the pacesetter two wide approaching the final turn, battled through the final turn and down the stretch from the outside of TEN THIRTY and prevailed for a hard fought victory. TEN THIRTY broke sharply and vied for the lead entering the first turn racing just out from the rail, was collared by MARKETWAY nearing the final turn, battled from along the inside of that rival through the final furlong, giving way grudgingly in the closing strides while proving clearly second best. BLUEGRASS MAN dueled for the lead into the first turn racing two from the rail, pressed the pace into the final turn but was unable to match strides with the top pair while fading in the stretch. PAYTON'S BEST away alertly but ducked in soon after the start, tracked the leaders from along the rail through the first turn, rallied four wide on the final turn, but needed more when called upon. I TOLD FRANK unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and failed to menace. LAZARIA LASS raced four wide into the first turn, advanced three from the rail mid way down the backstretch to loom a danger approaching the final turn, but weakened over the final furlong.
