Footnotes

LUCAVA chased the early leader one from the rail through the first turn, tracked three wide down the backside, rallied two from the rail on the final turn, took a narrow lead before entering the stretch and held the closers at bay late. GENTLEMAN BEN raced to the early lead from along the rail entering the first turn, dropped into a tracking position from along the rail entering the second turn, tipped four wide entering the stretch and closed willingly. WANDERING DREAMER chased the early pace through the first turn racing two from the rail, advanced three wide approaching the second turn and dropped over to vie for the lead from just off the rail into the backside, battled through the final turn from along the inside but was outfinished in the stretch drive. CASH LAND stalked the early pacesetters while racing just out from the rail through the stretch the first time, rallied three wide into the final turn and was gaining in the stretch from between rivals. IMDADUDEWITATITUDE rushed up five wide on the first turn to press the pace from the far outside entering the stretch the first time, dueled three wide into the second turn, held a narrow advantage into the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive. SAGEHILL'S STORM hopped at the start to get away slowly, saved ground through the second turn, advanced five wide mid way down the backstretch, but hung in the late going.
