### Footnotes

ETESIAN broke sharply and chased the early pacesetter while racing one from the rail into the first turn, pressed the pace two wide down the backside, held a narrow advantage into the final turn and inched clear through the stretch drive. FOLLOW MY ORDERS allowed to settle well off the early leaders through the stretch the first time racing one from the rail, rallied four wide entering the final turn and was gaining ground through the stretch to prove second best. HALO'S QUEST stalked the early pace while racing four wide into the second turn, pressed the pace three wide into the final turn but hung in the late going. COUNTRY CASH away alertly and chased the early pace three wide into the first turn, engaged four wide approaching the final turn to loom a danger, but was unable to sustain his bid. PUNA POINT unhurried early while dropping back to trail, saved ground throughout, rallied along the inside on the final turn, but was unable to make up ground in the stretch drive. MR. PRINCIPE showed no speed while lagging well back, raced three wide throughout and failed to be a factor. BRAVE BOLT pulled early while having to be restrained while behind rivals, stalked the pace from along the rail entering the second turn, but weakened over the final furlong. ACTION JAXON away well and raced to the lead entering the first turn from just off the rail, vied from along the inside mid way down the backside, but began to fade approaching the final turn.
