Footnotes

FRANSOR'S FINEST settled well back early while racing one from the rail into the second turn, rallied two wide on the final turn, and closed with a rush to be up in time. DEVIL IN DISGUISE away well and stalked the leaders through the second turn racing one from the rail, rallied three wide on the final turn, took command soon after entering the stretch but was unable to hold off a fast closing FRANSOR'S FINEST in the final strides. STRATIFY broke awkwardly, and trailed the field into the first turn, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed willingly four wide in the stretch drive. THE GOV away alertly and tracked the leader from along the inside entering the first turn, battled through the final turn from the inside of STORMY CANUCK, but faded in the stretch. STORMY CANUCK broke sharply and raced to a narrow lead entering the first turn racing one out from the rail, continued on the lead entering the backstretch racing three wide, held a narrow lead through the final turn but weakened in the drive. GYPSY MAGIC stalked the pace from along the rail through the stretch the first time, began to drop back in the run down the backstretch, and offered little late.
