**Footnotes**

MY BAILOUT stalked the early pace while racing three wide into the first turn, rallied two from the rail entering the final turn, took command entering the stretch and drew clear. ALEVEI broke sharply and pressed the early pace two wide into the first turn, took a narrow lead mid way through the final turn, was unable to match strides with the winner in the stretch drive, but battled gamely to prove second best. B. C. CAT allowed to settle well off the early leader while racing five wide into the first turn, continued on from the outside down the backside, rallied five wide on the final turn, and improved her position through the final furlong without ever threatening. DREAM IN THE DARK allowed to settle off the early leaders entering the first turn while saving ground at the rail, advanced from along the inside mid way down the backside, steadied briefly from along the rail nearing the final turn, and closed willingly eight wide through the stretch to improve her position. DECARZIA away alertly and tracked the leaders into the first turn from along the rail, held a striking position down the backstretch racing one from the rail, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. MAIDA VALE away well and rushed to the lead from along the inside entering the first turn, held a narrow advantage into the final turn but faded over the final furlong. CALL ME JEWEL unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied four wide through the final turn and finished seven wide in the stretch while unable to menace. PRINCESS RAINIER bobbed soon after the start and was squeezed between rivals in the run to the first turn, tracked the leaders one from the rail down the backside, but weakened entering the final turn.
