JUMP TO IT chased the early pacesetter racing one from the rail, pressed three wide into the second turn,collared COSTA MARTA entering the final turn and quickly opened a clear lead as she pulled away from the field. COSTA MARTA away alertly, led from the onset from along the rail, was collared entering the final turn and while no match for the winner, she was clearly second best. NASCOPIE unhurriedly early, trailed the field into the final turn while racing four wide, rallied five wide on the turn and into the stretch, and was gaining in the lane. MAGIC THUNDER raced three wide throughout and was only able to post a mild bid without ever threatening. SONGSROYALDIAMOND away well, chased the early leader while saving ground at the rail,but faded in the final furlong. FLAMES ABLAZIN raced three wide while mid pack and never menaced. TAMAHAI broke sharply and stalked the pacesetters while racing three wide, and weakened in the late stages. DANCING DALIA raced two wide throughout and was never a factor.
