MCGILL away alertly, stalked the early pacesetter while saving ground at the rail, slipped through along the inside mid way through the final turn and quickly drew clear. GRASS ROOTS bumped at the start, advanced two wide upon entering the backstretch, rallied along the inside on the final turn and proved to be clearly second best. J J'S ORCHID bumped at the start, rushed up to lead entering the first turn while racing along the rail, held a narrow advantage entering the final turn, drifted off the rail mid way through the turn and weakened late. DRAFTING FOR SPEED raced three and four wide throughout, but improved her position in the stretch without ever threatening. DELTA BOUQUET saved ground throughout while racing along the rail but never seriously menaced. INCLUDE THE GRAND broke sharply, chased the early pace two wide into the first turn and down the backstretch, but began to fade nearing the final turn. QUICKENS raced wide throughout and was never a factor. SALES GAL ducked out at the start and bumped rivals to her immediate outside, trailed while saving ground, and showed little.
