### Footnotes

ALL THE VICES broke sharply, chased from between horses, gained the lead on the the turn, prevailed driving. JEANNIE LIZ broke sharply, gained command from three wide, set the pace, gave way. DRAFTING FOR SPEED hustled along, steadily advanced from off the rail, weakened in the stretch. SOCKS ON SOCKS OFF unhurried early, gaining on the inside, was outrun in the stretch. NEVER ASSUME unhurried early, stalked the pace from off the rail, failed to menace. FINAL PLEASURE close up on the inside, stumbled and steadied leaving the backstretch, lacked a late response. V. V. CHA CHING broke slowly, trailed and showed little.
