QUECHEE away well and tracked the early leaders racing just out from the rail into the stretch the first time, tracked the leader two from the rail into the second turn, advanced three wide mid way down the backstretch to loom a danger, battled through the final turn from the inside of KWIK, and drew clear through the stretch drive. KWIK unhurried early while dropping back to trail, advanced four wide soon after entering the backstretch, battled through the final turn from the outside of QUECHEE, was no match for that rival through the stretch but proved clearly second best. TEXAS BUCCANEER broke sharply, but settled mid pack while racing one from the rail entering the stretch the first time, advanced from along the rail mid way down the backside, tipped three wide to commence his rally entering the final turn, improved his position but was unable to threaten the top pair. KALOOKAN BOSS away alertly, but was allowed to settle off the early pace while saving ground at the rail, rallied two wide on the final turn, and improved his position without ever threatening. HORNBLOWER vied for the lead into the stretch the first time racing along the rail, held the lead approaching the final turn, but had little left when collared by QUECHEE and KWIK and weakened in the late stages. OUTOFTHECLOUDS showed no early speed while lagging well back of the early leaders racing three wide, and failed to ever be a factor. KENTUCKY CLIPPER dueled for the lead one from the rail through the first turn, battled with HORNBLOWER into the backstretch, but was through soon thereafter.
