**Footnotes**

DIANA'S LEGACY allowed to settle through the early stages racing one from the rail, advanced four wide mid way down the backstretch, rallied three wide on the final turn, took command entering the stretch and was able to hold GOLDEN RATIO safely at bay. the rider dropped his whip nearing the wire. GOLDEN RATIO showed no speed while lagging well back, raced wide into the first turn, raced two from the rail down the backstretch, rallied five wide on the final turn and was gaining ground quickly through the stretch. BESPOKE unhurried early while dropping back to trail in the run to the first turn, rallied three wide on the final turn and closed willingly one from the rail through the stretch. TAMARINDA away alertly and stalked the early pace from along the inside, tracked the leaders from just off the rail into the final turn, tipped four wide into the stretch and finished with some late interest. INCLUDE THE GRAND broke sharply and tracked the early leaders three wide into the backstretch, loomed three wide entering the final turn, but hung through the stretch. R DUBAI GIRL allowed to settle off the early leaders racing three wide into the backside, raced five wide into the final turn but lacked the needed closing response. NICOTIANA away well and dueled for the lead from the outside of JOEY'S JEWEL entering the first turn, put that rival away approaching the final turn, battled through the turn from the inside of INCLUDE THE GRAND, but weakened in the stretch drive. JOEY'S JEWEL vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, but began to tire entering the final turn.
