TEQUISQUIAPAN away alertly, pressed the pace from three wide, gained the lead on the backstretch, just failed to last. LEGO MAN away alertly, stalked the pace, made a middle move from three wide, finished well. T J GEMINI broke sharply, gained command from the inside, set a pressured pace, gave way. COUNTRY KID broke sharply, pressed the pace from between horses, was through after the half. FEAR ITSELF trailed, suffered from broken equipment and was pulled up entering the backstretch.
