SUNNY SURI slow early, gaining on the inside, rallied on the the two path and was up for the place. SHEL B QUICK away alertly and close up, three wide on the backstretch, gained the lead on the second turn, gave way. DHARMA QUEEN broke sharply, gained command, set a pressured pace, gave way. NITE TIME NEWS trailed for the first half mile, put in a mild bid from three wide to gain a minor share. OLLIE KAT unhurried early, stalked the pace from the inside, failed to menace. BAKARI in the middle of the pack, tracked the leaders from three and four wide, was through after the half. EPIC MELODY broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, was through after the half.
