Footnotes

TIGRESS LILY broke sharply and pressed the early pacesetter through the stretch the first time racing one from the rail, held a narrow advantage into the second turn and down the backstretch, opened a clear lead entering the final turn and quickly drew off. EXOTIC LIGHT pressed the pace three wide through the stretch the first time, duled for the lead into the backstretch from the outside of TIGRESS LILY, was unable to match strides with that rival through the final furlong but proved clearly second best. SECRET SATIN showed no early speed while lagging well back, saved ground throughout and was only able to improve her position through the stretch without ever threatening. GRIEVANCE unhurried early while dropping back to trail, raced three wide into the final turn, and improved her position through the stretch drive. FLAMES ABLAZIN allowed to settle off the early leaders into the backstretch while racing one from the rail, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. HASTY REPLY away alertly and raced to a narrow lead from along the rail into the first turn, drooped back to assume a tracking position through the stretch the first time, held a striking position into the final turn, but weakened over the final furlong.
