Footnotes

FUNNY FACE away alertly and raced to a narrow advantage one from the rail entering the first turn, battled down the backstretch from along the inside. held a slight advantage into the stretch and closed along the rail to finish on even terms with MONSTERINTHECLOSET. MONSTERINTHECLOSET unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied five wide entering the final turn, and closed with a rush six wide in the stretch to finish on even terms with FUNNY FACE. DYNA STROLL away well and tracked the leader through the first turn while saving ground at the rail, rallied four wide entering the final turn,

and closed willingly four wide in the lane to just miss. RIBOLETTO stumbled at the start, but recovered quickly and took up a tracking position two from the rail into the first turn, pressed the pace into the final turn racing three wide, and finished well to just miss in a solid effort. BLADE SCUFFLER stalked the pace into the first turn racing one from the rail, rallied four wide entering the final turn, dropped to the inside entering the stretch, but lacked room in the lane while full of run. NOW ACT broke sharply, and tracked the leader into the backstretch racing one from the rail, rallied two wide through the final turn, was forced to steady sharply leaving the turn, and never fully recovered. TIME MACHINE lagged well back early while racing one from the rail into the backstretch, and showed little. DOG ROCK stalked the leaders into the first turn racing three from the rail, advanced four wide entering the backstretch to press the pace to the final turn, but weakened over the final furlong. Following the running of this race there was a jockey's claim of foul. The rider of NOW ACT lodged a claim of foul against the rider of BLADE SCUFFLER for alleged interference at the eighth pole. After review the stewards made no change to the original order of finish.
