Footnotes

DELTA BOUQUET pressed the early pacesetter while racing one from the rail, took command on the final turn and drew clear in the stretch. BESPOKE raced three wide into the first turn, advanced three wide down the backstretch to enter contention, rallied two wide on the final turn and proved second best while unable to threaten the winner. WESTERN DELTA unhurried early, raced one from the rail throughout and improved her position in the final furlong. GOLDEN RATIO broke sharply, raced one from the rail into the first turn, tipped four wide down the backstretch to post a mild bid, raced four wide on the final turn and into the stretch and hung in the late stages. SALES GAL away alertly, led through the first half while racing along the rail, but weakened in the final furlong. TRIBAL SECRET raced along the rail, but never menaced. EMERALD CITY away well, steadied nearing the first turn, drifted four wide on the turn and was through early.
