**Footnotes**

TALLY STICK broke sharply, and tracked the dueling leaders into the backstretch racing one from the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed willingly three wide in deep stretch to get up in the final strides. FOURTEENFORTY away alertly, and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, battled through the final turn from the inside of CHECKERPLATE, and was nipped in the final stride. CHECKERPLATE dueled for the lead one from the rail into the first turn, battled through the final turn, and down the stretch from the outside of FOURTEENFORTY, only to be nipped at the wire. CAR TALK (IRE) stalked the early pace while racing one from the rail, advanced from along the inside in the run to the final turn, and closed with late interest one from the rail in the drive. SECOND ECLIPSE settled well off the early pace racing one from the rail into the backside, rallied two wide on the final turn, but needed more of a closing response in the lane. ROCK' N ROLLER settled off the early leaders racing three wide into the backstretch, rallied two from the rail entering the final turn, but needed more in the late going while closing six wide. OTTOMAN hopped at the start to get away slowly, trailed into the backstretch, rallied two wide on the final turn, but was never a serious factor. CONTACT MAN hopped at the start, but recovered quickly and tracked the leaders three wide into the backstretch, but began to fade approaching the final turn. BUENO'S LEGACY away well, and tracked the leaders from along the rail into the first turn, but was through soon after entering the backstretch.
