Footnotes

EL CAPONE settled well off the early pace into the backstretch racing one from the rail, rallied smartly from just off the rail over the final furlong, and took command three wide shortly after entering the stretch and drew clear. STOLE IT away alertly, and vied for the lead from along the rail approaching the first turn, took back to track the pacesetter entering the turn racing one from the rail, rallied two wide entering the final turn, took a brief lead into the stretch, but was quickly tackled by EL CAPONE, but proved clearly second best. HOPESEEKER away well, and angled in to save ground at the rail entering the first turn, stalked the leader one from the rail in the run down the backstretch, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed willingly in the stretch drive. BRIDGE JUMPER dueled for the lead one from the rail in the run to the first turn, took command entering the turn, held the lead into the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive. SHOTGUN RALPH broke sharply, and stalked the leaders into the backstretch while racing two from the rail, but began to weaken approaching the final turn. STEPUPFORTHEMONEY stumbled soon after the start to get away poorly, and trailed throughout.
